


Taxation After Long Resistance



<p>Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>The main types of embossed coat of arms</p> <p>Type I: the ribbons start above eagle heads against the beaks later. Occurring in issues before 1840 and normally not used in Hungary.</p> <p>Type II: a gap of various widths under the curved bottom shield. Production from 1840 to 1850 rarely used also in Hungary.</p> <p>Type III: no gap between the coat of arms and crest. Production from 1840 to 1850 but often used in Hungary.</p> <p>Type IV: narrow and taller coat of arms, mostly very faint embossing. Productions from 1850 to 1854 generally used in Hungary for printed and stamped signs both.</p> <p>All stamped signs have this type.</p> <p>Multiple usage of Drillingstempel signs von Perlh (W.I) with type IV of embossed coat of arms.</p>	<p>Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>Type Ia</p> <p>The shield divided vertically; the tail feather is small and closed.</p> <p>Type Ib</p> <p>The shield divided horizontally; the tail is large and opened.</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>10 Kr 10 G 1 G 6 G</p> <p>Subtypes normally not used in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIa</p> <p>Big shield; the gap below is narrow.</p> <p>Type IIa</p> <p>Small shield of 2.0x2.8 mm, big grided gap below.</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>6 Kr 10 Kr 3 Kr 15 Kr</p> <p>Discovered subtypes in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIa</p> <p>Small shield of 2.0x2.8 mm, big grided gap below.</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>2 Kr 20 Kr 1 Kr 4 Kr</p>

Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIb</p> <p>Higher shield; with small grided gap</p> <p>Type IIIa</p> <p>Big and wide 3.4x3.5 mm shield; no gap below</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>3 Kr 45 Kr 10 Kr</p> <p>6 Kr 45 Kr 10 Kr</p> <p>Discovered subtypes in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIIa</p> <p>3.2x3.7 mm shield, the middle feather under the wing is thin and long</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>3 Kr 6 Kr 10 Kr 15 Kr</p> <p>Type IIIb</p> <p>3.3x4 mm shield, the middle feather under the wing is thicker and short</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>10 Kr 10 Kr 10 Kr 10 Kr</p> <p>Discovered subtypes in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIIb</p> <p>3.3x4 mm shield, the middle feather under the wing is thicker and short</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>1 G 6 G 10 G 20 G</p> <p>also known: 15 Kr</p>

Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>Discovered subtypes in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIIc</p> <p>Small shield, only two feathers are visible under the wing</p> <p>Type IIId</p> <p>Small shield, only one feather is visible under the wing</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>3 Kr 6 Kr 15 Kr 18 G</p> <p>3 Kr 10 Kr 15 Kr 18 G</p>	<p>Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>Type IIIa</p> <p>Small shield, ribbon tips looking downwards</p> <p>Type IIIb</p> <p>Small shield, ribbon tips almost horizontal</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>3 Kr 8 G 10 G 12 G</p> <p>8 G 10 G 12 G 15 G</p>	<p>Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary</p> <p>Type IVa</p> <p>Small and narrow shield, dull stamping</p> <p>Type IVb</p> <p>small rectangular shield, dull stamping, only known with silver</p> <p>Examples</p> <p>1 Kr 3 Kr 5 Kr 10 Kr</p> <p>1 Kr</p>



Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary

High taxes: 8 ft U3 stamped signet

Stamped signet with letters U3 (Kassa) in document. Only known in private hands




Land lease contract for 824 Gulden 10 Kreuzer amount pro year in Mikofaza with appropriate tariff. The contract was valid for 3 years, base of the 8 Gulden tax is 2,473.5 Gulden. See scale on the following sheet.

High taxes: 10 Gulden printed signet

Embossed type IIIcb



Received for 3833 Gulden and 38 Kreuzer in Guaya. (= Bank in German name) 17 oct 1874




Only known first month usage of the 12 Gulden signet in Hungary.


High taxes: 14 Gulden printed signet



Promissory note for 5,000 Gulden in Raab with 14 Gulden printed signet (20.03.1852).
Correct taxing: 14 Gulden was payable for values from 4,800 until 5,600 forint.

Part 2. Austrian taxing in Hungary

High taxes: 16 Gulden printed signet



*Promissory note and receipt in the backside for 1,000 + 1,060 = 2,060 Gulden in Telšiai-Tengelitz (08.08.1851).
Incorrect taxing: the demand was only 6 Gulden for values from 2,000 until 2,400 forint.*
